Anyone who is an instructor anywhere is not eligible to submit a painting for this exhibit, even though they may take classes at PSAA. Matting must be white or off white. No colored mats. A colored ¼ inch inner mat is acceptable.

Drop Off	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> September 29th from 5:00 pm until 7:00 pm September 30th from 10:00 am until Noon
Pick Up	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To be determined in December for January.
Fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> There is no fee for this show.
Awards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Awards will be determined by three wonderful township people. First, second, third and honorable mention ribbons will be given.
Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please be sure to adhere to the Gallery Hanging Requirements or your entry(s) will not be accepted for display. Entries must remain on display in the gallery for the duration of the show.

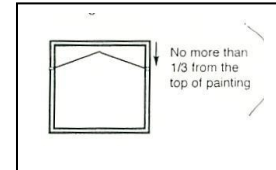

Hanging Guidelines for Participation In Student Art Shows

Your painting will not be accepted if the following guidelines are not followed:

- Matting must be white or off white. No colored mats.
- A colored $\frac{1}{4}$ inch inner mat is acceptable.
- Unframed canvas paintings must have gallery finish (no tape or staples showing). The sides must be a continuation of the painting or painted black only.
- Entry must not exceed 32" x 40" including mat and frame.
- In lieu of glass, Plexiglas must be used on all paintings larger than 20" x 26".
- Badly joined frames, smudged mats, smeared glass, and ragged, wavy, or over cut mat corners will not be accepted.
- Our hanging system requires that screw eyes be placed a $\frac{1}{3}$ of the way from the top of the frame. Wire hanging only. No saw tooth hangers or the triangle hooks on the backing board.
- Wire should be slightly taught.
- Wrap wire ends with tape. Do not connect in the middle.
- Metal frames must have proper hangers (no clips) with wire.
- Unapproved early drop offs will not be in the show.
- Entry previously exhibited in a PSAA Show will not be accepted.
- Entry must have been completed within the last three (3) years.
- Entry must remain on display in the gallery for the duration of the show. There will be no exceptions to this requirement. Constant abuse of this could result in exclusion from the next year's exhibit.



Artists are responsible for insuring their work. All reasonable care will be taken in handling the art work. PSAA will not be responsible for work damaged, lost, or stolen, however caused, while works are in the Association's possession or in transit. Any work left after close of exhibition will be stored at the owner's risk. Works not retrieved within 3 months of final date of exhibition will be considered Association donations and may be disposed of as determined by action of the Board of Trustees. Your entry into this exhibition constitutes agreement with these terms, and your permission for your work to be photographed for an exhibition, catalog, or publicity purposes regardless of copyright.
